



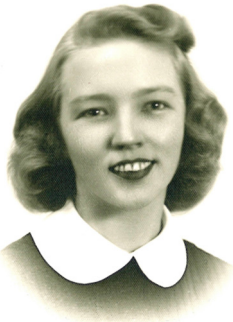
A lasting memorial has been given to
