David was the son of Doug and Avaunne Hed. He had two brothers, Tom and Roger. He attended Good Samaritan Church beginning in 1965, when his family moved to Edina.

He went to Good Samaritan Sunday School and was confirmed at the church. He also went to Methodist Youth Fellowship and served on the Youth Council. In Sunday School, he and other sixth grade boys would often make it difficult for their teacher. When the teacher had enough, she told the class that from now on they would have to go to church with their parents. David begged his mom and dad to take over the class which they did.



David was in Indian Guides and a member of Boy Scout Troop 68. He became an Eagle Scout. He went to the Scout Camp at Ponsford, Minnesota and to the Philmount Scout Camp in Cimarron, New Mexico. David sewed his own tent from a kit. He was also part of a two week camping trip across Minnesota representing the State Governor. The troop started the trip at the State Capital in St. Paul and even stayed on his relative's farm near New London, Minnesota.

He really enjoyed helping Dad, Mom and Tom build a lake cabin. He was the "Go For" in 1970 and later helped build an addition on the cabin. He had his own Sun Fish sailing boat as a youngster and loved sailing the 16 foot Chrysler Mutineer sailboat, with main sail, jib and spinnaker.

David liked to take things apart and put them back together to make them better – especially cars. He liked camping, hiking, fishing, skiing, hunting and even enjoyed playing the organ. He made a three screen slide presentation for the U.M.W. for his Eagle project. The presentation was also shown to many other Edina organizations.

David and his best friend, Bruce Malin, were killed in an automobile accident.
